

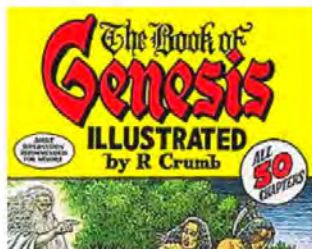

Have you ever read the Hebrew Bible? Or did someone read the stories to you when you were a child, but you haven't revisited them since then? Perhaps you are familiar with some biblical narratives but want to delve into them again. In this weekly workshop designed for undergraduate and graduate students, we will closely read some of the main stories of the Hebrew Bible in translation, comparing a few renditions and discovering what has been lost in translation from the original Hebrew. We will explore different ways of interpreting the narrative and traces traditional Jewish and Christian trajectories of interpretation. We will also look at art that depicts these stories, and will hear your input.

No previous knowledge of Hebrew or of the Bible is necessary - just come open-minded!
