



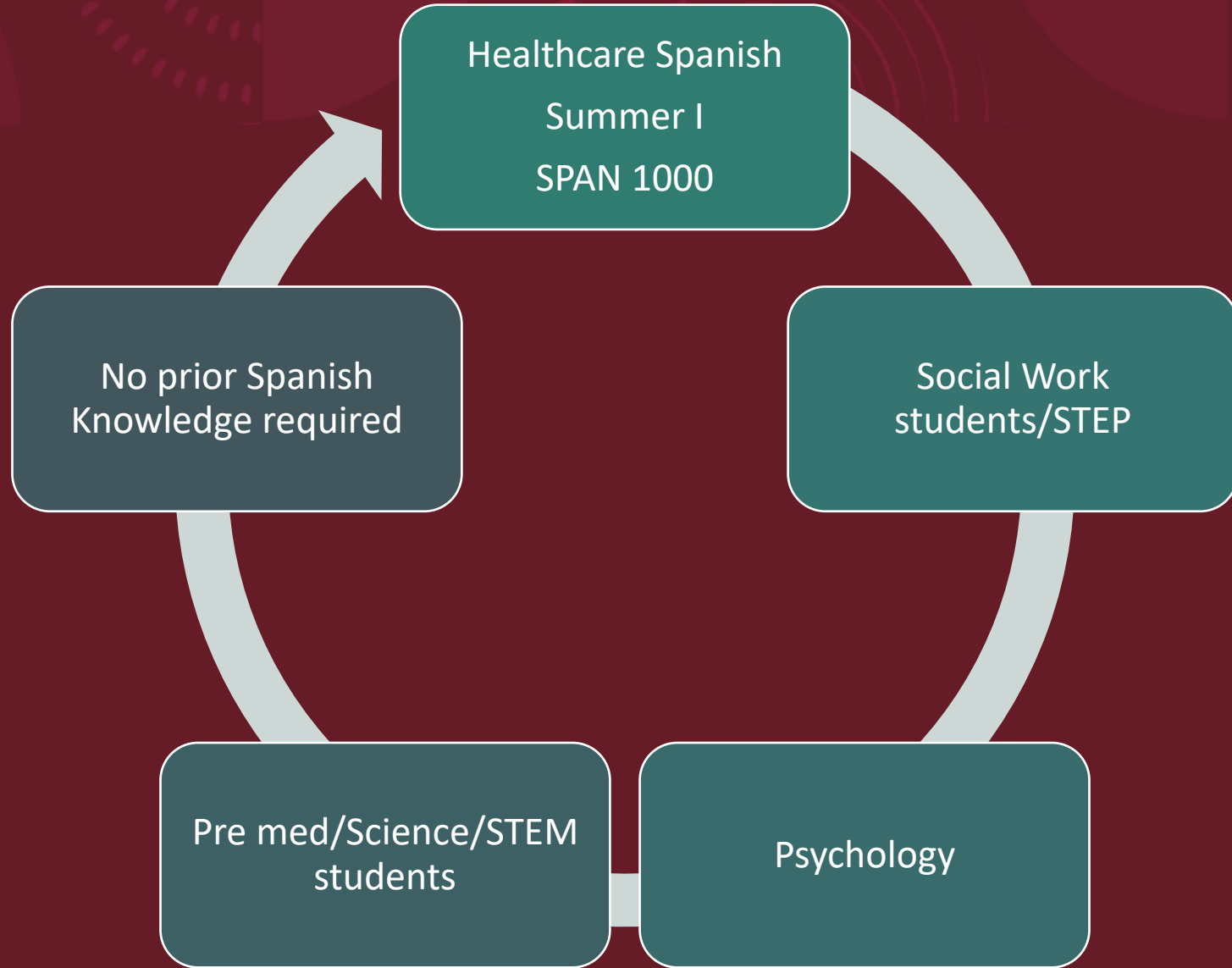

SPAN 1000, INTRODUCTION TO HEALTHCARE SPANISH: COURSE DESCRIPTION, SUMMER I

- The course is specifically designed so that students that have never taken Spanish start learning the language with a very specific communicative goal: To successfully interact with patients within the Healthcare context. By the end of this course, students would be familiar with the vocabulary and basic grammar that would enable their understanding of Healthcare Spanish at an introductory level. The syntactic and vocabulary selected for this course, aims at a practical use of language within this very specific medical professional field. Attention will also be devoted to the socio-pragmatic aspect of language, providing the students with the necessary sociocultural knowledge to succeed when interacting in a healthcare communicative context.

SPAN 2405, HEALTHCARE SPANISH: COURSE DESCRIPTION, SUMMER II, 2022

This course is specifically designed so that students that have an intermediate language proficiency level , can get the tools needed to successfully communicate with a patient in the Healthcare setting. Conducting the clinical interview in the target language and assessing the Chief complaint (Whether physical or mental) will be the main target of SPAN 5405. The starting point of all the materials used in this class will be a reflection on the Hispanic community and their socio-cultural reality within the Healthcare encounter. Therefore, this course could be of interest also to students that are not in the medical field, but linguistically want to further develop that cultural awareness while learning the language from a new clinical angle.
